

Championship Points for COBS Club Champions

As per Constitution 6 (a) COBS Championships will only be awarded to cavies owned by a club financial member.

(Effective May 2008, replaces any previous rules and requirements)

(updated January 22, 2012)

The idea behind this Championship is to promote COBS cavy club shows. To receive this award you must have 15 points in total.

Points can be achieved by the following:

- 6 Best in Show
- 5 Reserve in Show
- 4 Best in Group (2 for BOB + 2 for Group)
- 1 Reserve in Group
- 2 Best of Breed
- 2 Breed Challenge (only awarded to non-champion animals where BOB is won by a Champion and Reserve of Breed goes to a non-champion.)

The 6 points awarded to BIS winner is the maximum number of points achievable at any one COBS Club show unless otherwise allowed. Points awarded at State Titles, Royal Shows and the National will be doubled. Double points will only be awarded at any COBS hosted Agricultural Show or COBS Club Show where total number of pedigree animals exhibited exceeds 140 cavies. Scratchings will not count towards this total. This will not affect double points awarded for State Titles, the National or Royal Shows. COBS will now accept points from other clubs to a maximum of 4 out of our 15 Club Championship points, noting that National, Royal Shows and State title points will be classified as COBS Club points.

Grand Champions require 30 points in total and may not claim further points from other clubs if these points have been claimed previously.

Double Grand Champion (October 23, 2011): this will require a further 15 points on top of the 30 required for Grand Champion. No further points can be claimed from non-COBS shows if the four points have previously been claimed.

Supreme Championship (February 26, 2012): can only be awarded after a cavy has been awarded a Double Grand Championship. The idea is to recognise cavies that can compete well at group and show levels.

The Supreme Championship will comprise of 15 points tallied after an animal received a Double Grand Championship. A cavy that is awarded a Double Grand Championship may become eligible for a Supreme Championship at the same time, or it may need to compete at further shows.

Points can be obtained from any combination of the following:

- Best in Show – 3
- Reserve in Show – 2
- Best in Group – 2
- Age Group in Show – 1

Claiming Points from other Clubs

Don't forget that COBS will recognise up to 4 points worth of Wins at other clubs. You need to formally tell the Pointscorer (by mail, email or even phone) within 7 working days and then present originals plus photo copies of your Signed certificates by the next COBS Show to be able to claim them.

It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to inform the Pointscorer not the Pointscorer's responsibility to chase up your points from other clubs.
