ADDITIONAL CLASSES

For the following classes place an 'X' against the cavy in the appropriate column

PET CLASSES

1. Most Colourful Pet
2. Best Conditioned & Groomed Pet
3. Best Pet Boar
4. Best Pet Sow
5. Cutest Pet

Winners of the above Classes are eligible for Best & Reserve Pet. Other pet classes may be held. This will depend on time restraints and interest on the day.

ENTRY CRITERIA & INFORMATION

1. *Date of Birth (DOB)*

If there is no DOB supplied with entry in the Standard Breed Classes the animal will be moved to the Boar or Sow class, unless a pedigree is produced on the day of the show.

2. *Standard Breed Section Class Definitions*

Baby: 3 months – under 6 months

Junior: 6 months – under 9 months

Adult Boar: over 9 months

Adult Sow: over 9 months

PLEASE NOTE: BABIES AGED UNDER THREE MONTHS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BE SHOWN IN ANY CLASS INCLUDING PET CLASSES. IF A JUDGE DEEMS AN ANIMAL TOO YOUNG PROOF OF AGE MAY BE REQUIRED. IF NOT AVAILABLE THE CAVY MAY BE DISQUALIFIED.

3. *Junior Handler*

To be eligible for the Junior Handler End of Year Pointscore juniors aged under 13 years may nominate on their entry forms up to two Standard Breed cavies per show. They must handle these animals for the entire show. This does not stop them handling other animals however points will only be counted from the nominated cavies.

4. Youth Handler

To be eligible for the Junior Handler End of Year Pointscore Youths aged 13 to under 18 years may nominate on their entry forms up to two Standard Breed cavies per show. They must handle these animals for the entire show. This does not stop them handling other animals however points will only be counted from the nominated cavies.

5. Pets

Animals entered in the pet classes are NOT eligible to enter the Standard breed classes.

6. Showing COBS & QCC Champions

Champions may be shown in all classes, unless specifically stated.

7. Showing COBS Non-Champions

Champions may compete for Best of Breed points at COBS shows. If they win Best of Breed they may obtain further points at the group and show level, and compete for class in group and show awards.

8. Conditions of Entry

All exhibitors whether members or not are expected to follow all COBS show rules and guidelines which are available for viewing on the website and on show day.

All exhibitors must clean your area before you leave the show.

Photographs of you or your cavies may be used in COBS club promotional material, on club websites and other documents.

9. Scratchings

Any Scratchings made AFTER the closing date must be paid for.
