Best and Reserve in Baby Sweepstakes Trophies

These are awarded to the winner and runner up in the Annual Baby Sweepstakes Competition.

History - Began in 2000 as part of celebrations welcoming in the new millennium. The Best and Reserve in Sweepstakes Perpetual Trophies are made from timber and are shaped like a shield. They were made by COBS life member Keith Lakin. The Sweepstakes encourage exhibitors to have their younger animals judged against others of their own age group. Cavies from all seven groups compete against each other in a sweepstakes draw.

The inaugural Best Baby in Baby Sweepstakes winner was a Peruvian, Jayann Buffalo Bill owned by J & J Boyes (Jayann). The Boyes also won the Reserve in Baby Sweepstakes at the inaugural event with another Peruvian, Jayann Happy Hawaii.
